The Electrical and Computer Engineering Department offers a program totaling 30 credit hours, leading to the degree of Master of Science in Engineering (Computer Engineering). Students desiring admission to the program must have earned a Bachelor's degree in Electrical and/or Computer Engineering with an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher. Students whose undergraduate background is in a field other than Electrical or Computer Engineering may be granted admission and required to take preparatory courses in electrical and/or computer engineering as described in section V.

All graduate-level engineering courses are scheduled during late afternoons or evenings to enable students to earn their master's degree through part-time or full-time study. 

EXTENSION OF PROGRAM. If you cannot complete the education program by the program end date on page 1 of your Form I-20, you should contact your DSO at least 15 days before the program end date to request an extension.

SCHOOL TRANSFER. To transfer schools, first notify the DSO at the school you are attending of your plan to transfer, then obtain a Form I-20 from the DSO at the school you plan to attend.
