The following points were discussed in the meeting

1. Review of Previous BOS Meeting Minutes

The meeting began with a comprehensive review of the minutes from previous Board of Studies meetings. Members discussed the action taken on previously suggested curriculum changes. Minor corrections were proposed and incorporated. Minutes from previous individual BOS meetings were reviewed and approved with minor modifications where necessary. The minutes were then formally approved

2. Finalization of 3rd & 4th Semester Courses and Syllabus (AY 2025–26)

Course structures and syllabi for the 3rd and 4th semesters were discussed. Updates were incorporated based on recent industry trends and academic feedback. Each department presented the revised syllabi and course structures for the 3rd and 4th semesters. Industry relevance, academic rigor, and outcome-based education principles were considered. After thorough review and discussion, the proposed syllabi were finalized.

3. Common Courses Across Engineering Branches

A list of common core and elective courses was presented to ensure uniform learning outcomes across disciplines. Departments agreed to collaborate on resource sharing for these courses. It was resolved that common courses would be delivered using interdisciplinary teaching teams. Identification and finalization of common courses applicable to all engineering disciplines for uniformity. Inter-departmental coordination agreed upon for delivery of these courses.

4. CIE (Continuous Internal Evaluation) Assessment Methods

Various assessment models for CIE were discussed, focusing on transparency, fairness, and effectiveness. A blended model combining written tests, assignments, quizzes, and project work was approved. This is intended to improve student engagement and practical learning. Various

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assessment methods were proposed and discussed. Consensus was reached to adopt a mix of objective, descriptive, and project-based evaluations for enhanced student learning outcomes.

5. Finalization of 5th to 8th Semester Scheme

Proposed schemes for the 5th to 8th semesters were presented by departments. Departments proposed updates to the curriculum for the final four semesters, emphasizing flexibility, specialization, and industry-oriented electives. The proposed schemes were reviewed, and feedback was provided. Final versions were approved after discussion. Modifications were suggested and incorporated for better curriculum alignment with current industry needs.

6. Inclusion of Online Courses in the Curriculum

Discussion on integrating MOOCs and other certified online courses. The integration of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) and other certified online programs was discussed. Guidelines for selection, monitoring, evaluation of online learning modules and credit transfer were established. It was agreed that up to 2 online courses could be included for credit in the UG curriculum.

7. Other Academic Matters

Suggestions from members were invited. Miscellaneous academic matters were discussed with the permission of the chair, including faculty training and student engagement initiatives. With the chair's permission, discussions included initiatives to enhance faculty development, student project incubation, and internship opportunities. Departments were encouraged to collaborate with industry partners to enrich the learning ecosystem.

The meeting concluded at 1:30 PM with a vote of thanks by the Dean-Academics.
