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MINUTES OF MEETING

The VIIth Joint BoS Meeting was conducted in boardroom at 9.30A.M on 4th September 2025. Dr. L. Rangaiah, Dean - Academics welcomed all the members and presided over the meeting. The Joint BoS members are as follows.

1. Review and Finalization of 1st Year 2025 Scheme and Syllabus of UG Programmes

- The proposed scheme and syllabus for all UG programmes (2025 admission batch) were presented by respective HoDs.
- Inputs were taken from external subject experts and industry representatives to ensure curriculum relevance to current technological and industrial demands.
- Key points discussed:
- Incorporation of value-added courses and skill-based learning in the curriculum.
- Ensuring alignment with NEP-2020 guidelines and VTU norms.
- Introduction of interdisciplinary electives at later stages with foundational preparation in the 1st year.

Resolution: The Joint Board of Studies approved the finalized 1st Year 2025 Scheme and Syllabus (2025 admitted batch) after incorporating suggested modifications.

2. Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) and Semester End Examination (SEE)

A detailed discussion was held on CIE and SEE evaluation process of 4. 3, 1 credit courses.

ASSESSMENT STRUCTURE:

The assessment in each course is divided equally between Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) and the Semester End Examination (SEE), with each carrying 50% weightage. To qualify and become eligible to appear for SEE, in the CIE, a student must score at least 40% of 50 marks, i.e., 20 marks. To pass the SEE, a student must score at least 35% of 50 marks, i.e., 18 marks. Notwithstanding the above, a student is considered to have passed the course, provided the combined total of CIE and SEE is at least 40 out of 100 marks.

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SEMESTER END EXAMINATION (SEE)

1. The Question paper for each course contains two parts, Part – A and Part – B.
2. Part – A consists of **Short Answer Questions** (2 Marks/1 mark) for 20 marks covering the complete syllabus and it is compulsory. Multiple Choice Questions are not allowed.
3. Part – B consists of 10 questions, two questions of 16 marks (with max. of 3 sub questions) from each module with internal choice. Students shall answer five full questions, selecting one full question from each module.


Resolution: Joint Board of Studies approved the SEE evaluation structure and send to the Academic Council for approval.
